Disciplines

Ballet

The Ballet Performance Class is open to students 5th grade and up and is an opportunity for students to continue in their ballet training, adding strengthening and conditioning, vocabulary, and choreography as they continue to build upon the basics learned in their previously required ballet program. The class meets on Wednesdays from 3:15-5:00pm. From 3:15-3:45 students will focus on strength and conditioning, vocabulary, and reviewing basics, at 3:45 any students coming from Habersham Hall will join the class and it will continue with exercises at the barre, in center, and across the floor, adding for challenging and advanced technique.
